Food Safety Certification Assistance for Florida Specialty Crop Growers

The purpose of this Assistance program is to reimburse Florida growers of specialty crops 75% of costs they incur to obtain food safety certification for their specialty crop operations, up to a total of \$2,500 per applicant. Specialty crops are defined as fruits, vegetables, tree nuts, and horticulture products, including floriculture.

To qualify for reimbursement, the applicant must obtain food safety certification of its specialty crop producing operations between October 1, 2021 to September 1, 2022.

Reimbursement will be paid only for specialty crop commodity certification, and will be offered on a first-come, first-served basis until available funds are exhausted. Producers must be located within the state of Florida to be eligible for reimbursement, and the certified operations must also be within the state. Eligible food safety certifications will include those offered for specialty crops by the USDA GAP/GHP, GFSI, GlobalGAP, or SQF programs. To be eligible for reimbursement, applicants will be required to:

- 1. Preliminary steps before emailing an application for reimbursement:
 - a. Register your business in the MyFloridaMarketplace vendor system, which is operated by the Florida Department of Management Services.
 - b. Register your business with the <u>Florida Department of Financial Services vendor system</u> and provide a substitute W9 form.
- 2. Complete the application form and email it to SpecialtyCrop@FDACS.gov. Include the following documentation with the application:
 - a. Proof of successful certification, including location of certified operation(s) and certified commodities.
 - b. Invoices marked 'paid', cancelled checks, or other substantial documentation of any costs to be reimbursed.

Each operation may only receive one reimbursement per year the program is offered, and no operation may receive more than 75% of total certification costs or \$2,500.00 total reimbursement, whichever is lower.

Costs eligible for reimbursement are those directly related to the certification process, application fees, on-farm audit costs, travel expenses of auditors, or federal certification fees.

Costs not eligible for reimbursement include late fees, inspections due to violations, transitional certifications, materials and supplies, and equipment.
